### About the program:

Climate change, biodiversity loss, and environmental pollution are global threats facing the world in the 21st century. Human activities are not only causing unprecedented global changes in natural systems such as the climate, oceans, and biosphere, but are also currently affecting human health itself. For this reason, activities based on the perspective of planetary health, which protects human health, the environment, and social systems as a whole, are increasingly required both domestically and internationally.

This project targets young people from various backgrounds in Japan, the United States, and Thailand, and aims to foster human resources who will be active globally in the future through mutual understanding and collaboration through the program regarding planetary health issues that need to be resolved across borders. We will also compile concrete proposals for solving these issues as policy recommendations and disseminate them both domestically and internationally.

**Phase 1: Knowledge Introduction (Lectures)**Online lectures by planetary health experts from the US, Japan, and Thailand.

#### Phase 2: Case Study Formulation

Learn about each case study and meet online with academic mentors for planning in the fieldwork phase.

# Phase 3: Fieldwork in Thailand and development of policy recommendations

1-week fieldwork in Thailand (August) to meet with local stakeholders and collect data. Work in groups to analyze data and prepare policy recommendations memo.

Phase 4: Fieldwork and presentation of policy recommendations in Nagasaki, Japan Disseminate results and policy recommendations among peers and mentors.

## **Eligibility:**

- University and graduate students interested in the fields of global health, planetary health, and epidemiology (including international students)
- Young professionals with practical experience in the above fields (researchers, medical professionals, working adults, etc.)
- Those who have an **English level that allows** for group discussion and project work
- Past participants in G-HEP or GHSP: Global Health Summer Program are ineligible.
